- **Facility:** Takoma Aquatic Center is an indoor, 8 lane 50 meter by 25 yard competition pool. The length of the competition course with bulkhead is in compliance and on file with USMS in accordance with articles 105.1.7 and 106.2.1, but as a bulkhead course, is subject to length confirmation. The meet will be run in Long Course Meters (LCM) using 6 lanes with one warm-up/warm-down lane and a buffer lane available throughout the meet.

- **Timing System:** Primary - Colorado Fully Automatic, Secondary - Semi Automatic Button - Tertiary - Stop Watch. In the unlikely event that a malfunction occurs, the meet will continue on schedule with the use of hand-held stopwatch times. Times from this competition will be eligible for world record, USMS record, and Top 10 consideration.

- **Eligibility:** Open to any current 2026 USMS registered swimmers. Age on December 31, 2026 determines age group for USMS swimmers in the meet. Each swimmer will be allowed to swim up to five (5) relay events total and in only one category for each relay event. Each swimmer will be allowed to swim up to three (3) individual events.

- **Rules:** United States Masters Swimming rules will govern. Current PV LMSC meet procedures will be enforced and take precedence over any errors or omissions on this form. The meet referee will be in charge of the meet. Any questions regarding the conduct of the meet should be directed to that person.

- **Entry Fees:** \$30.00 per swimmer surcharge, payable through online entry.

**-Online registration closes Wednesday, June 10, at 11:59 PM. No deck entry of swimmers is allowed. (*Link to be provided*)**

- **Relays:** USMS Relays (consisting of four swimmers all from the same club) may enter online (*Link to be provided*) through Friday, June 12, at 11:59 PM. There are no relay team entry fees. Other relays may be deck entered at the meet.

- **Relay Entry Deadlines On Deck:** Relay cards for events 1 to 6 are due by 10:00 AM, events 7 to 13 by 10:30 AM, and events 14 to 19 by 11:00 AM.

- **Seeding:** All events will be deck seeded slowest to fastest, by entered time ages, and sexes.

**Donations to Adult Learn-to-Swim Program:** During checkout, you will be given the opportunity to contribute funds to our team's adult learn-to-swim program. The program offers swim lessons free of charge to adults in the Washington, DC area. Lessons are provided by Water Wizards team members who are certified adult learn-to-swim instructors through USMS. In 2025, we had 85 participants in our adult learn-to-swim program. Donations are tax-deductible; the DC Water Wizards is a *Section 501(c)(3) charitable organization*.
