IMPORTANT: You must be a 2026 member of USMS to enter this swim meet. Go to www.usms.org/reg/ to join or renew your USMS membership. No USMS one-event registration allowed.

DATE & TIME:

- **Saturday, October 17**
 - **Warm up:** 3:00PM
 - **Relay and positive check-in** for 400 IM: 3:30PM deadline
 - **Meet start:** 4:00PM
 - **Positive check-in** for 800 Free: 5:30PM deadline
- **Sunday, October 18**
 - **Warm up:** 8:00AM
 - **Relay and positive check-in** for 400 Free: 8:30AM deadline
 - **Meet start:** 9:00AM
 - **Positive check-in** for 1500 Free: 5:30PM deadline
- Note: Online check-in will be available starting at 12:00PM on Friday October 15, 2026.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

- 8 lanes, 25 meters
- The length of the competition course is in compliance and on file with USMS in accordance with articles 105.1.7 and 106.2.1, but as a bulkhead course, is subject to length confirmation.
- Eligibility of times for USMS Top 10 and records will be contingent on verification of bulkhead placement.

SANCTION:

- Sanctioned by LMSC for NC for USMS, Inc. Sanction #136-XXX

ENTRY FEES & LIMITS:

- Entry fee is \$30 *plus* \$12 per individual event
- Relay fee is \$20 per relay (\$5 per person x 4)
- There is a limit of 5 individual events PER SESSION (day). NO limit for relays.
- Your credit card will be charged by "Triangle Aquatic Center" for this swim meet.

RELAYS:

- Relays will be deck entered the day of the meet.
- Men's, Women's, and Mixed relays are combined into one event.

REFUNDS: NO refunds will be given, no exceptions, unless the meet is cancelled. If cancelled, refunds will be processed minus Club Assistant fees.

SEEDING METHOD: All events will be seeded from slow to fast. "No Time" is not allowed.

CONTINUOUS WARM-UP: Yes. TBD number of lanes available.

FACILITY:

- The Triangle Aquatic Center (TAC) has 3 indoor pools and 1 outdoor pool supporting amenities including a Spectator Stadium and Atrium with combined capacity of up to 1000, café, performance recovery center, hospitality gallery, classroom, and wireless internet. Select swim gear can be purchased from the vending machine in the lobby provided by Kiefer Aquatics. [View TAC facility](#).
- The 50-meter competition pool with bulkhead offers a total of 8 50-meter competition lanes with a depth of 7 to 12 feet that can be configured for separate 8-lane and 10-lane, 25-yard or 25-meter competition courses. TAC will ensure the correct competition course dimensions. Prior to each session of competition, the facility host shall examine the bulkhead and shall confirm to the Meet Referee that the bulkhead is stable, straight and properly positioned and anchored. The competition lanes are a minimum of 7 feet wide.
- Paddock Starting Blocks with Swim Innovation decks complete with Foot Wedge and optional non-mechanical backstroke ledges (at the meet referee's discretion) are available for all competition lanes.
- Water temperature is maintained between 79-81 degrees.
- TAC's Operations and Lifeguard staff will provide basic medical coverage throughout the facility and is fully supported by Wake County EMS.

PARKING: Meet participant parking is available across from the swimmer drop-off loop and in lot on the other side of Convention Drive. Illegally parked vehicles are liable to be ticketed or towed by the local Police Department and the owner's expense.

HOSPITALITY: There is a café on site. Water fountains/water bottle fillers are available.

TIMING SYSTEM:

- The primary timing system will be Swiss Timing Quantum timing which includes automated touch pads, at least one (1) semi-automatic plunger and at least one (1) watch per lane along with an HD video scoreboard.
- Times from this competition will be eligible for world record, USMS record, and Top 10 consideration.

RULES & ELIGIBILITY:

- Current USMS rules will govern the meet.
- All participants must be age 18 or older on the day of the meet and be currently registered members of U.S. Masters Swimming.
- Foreign swimmers must provide proof of current membership in their country's Masters Swimming governing body.
- The swimmer's competition age is their age on December 31, 2026.
- When warming up, you must enter the pool feet first except in designated sprint lanes. NO DIVING will be allowed during any breaks. No equipment is allowed in the competition course.

RESULTS, SCORING, AWARDS:

- There will be no team scoring and no awards.
- There will be special recognition for records broken.
- Results will be posted online on the [TAC website](#), ncmasters.org and southeastzone.org.
- Meet mobile will be used during the meet.

RESTRICTIONS ON CAMERAS & VIDEO:

- The use of cameras, including cellphone cameras and/or other recording devices, is prohibited behind the starting platforms during the start of races, including relay starts.
- The use of audio or visual recording devices, including cellphone cameras, is prohibited in changing areas, restrooms, and locker rooms.
